THE POINT

Listening skills are crucial to Knight of Eucharist Team Leader.

THE POINT, UNWRAPPED

Being a leader requires good listening skills so you can help your peers in crisis.

WHERE IN THE WORLD

John 10:27

²⁷My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

TEAM BUILDING

Listen Carefully

Everyone gets into a circle and one person is designated as the Source. Once the signal is given, the Source relays a message to the person to the right and the person to the right listens to the message and passes the message to the next person. This task is timed. When the message reaches the last person, the team checks to see if the correct message is transmitted and the length of time used. If the message is incorrect, the task is to do it over again until the right message is received. If the correct message is received, the group can brainstorm on how to beat the fastest time.
